## Honouring a kindly man!

At the 40<sup>th</sup> Changeover Night for the Fairlie Lions, Mr Colin Kinsman, outgoing President welcomed all the guests and gave a special welcome to Mr Jack Hutt.

The Fairlie Lions wanted to recognise the contribution Jack, and his late wife Enid, had given to the community of Fairlie and elsewhere (local, national and international Lions appeals) over a period of many years. Many organisations; including the Fairlie Lions; have been and still are benefactors of his generosity and help given in both a physical and financial sense.

In presenting this award Peter Hay said he could easily elaborate in considerable detail but I thought it was sufficient to say that Jack's philanthropic work had been carried out in a very quiet and understated manner. 



**Room for Improvement in Recycling**  
**Most of us agree that recycling is a good idea,**  
**but not everyone is taking the time to separate their**  
**rubbish correctly.**

The Mackenzie District's wheelie bin system has been operating for nearly two years. But there is still too much un-recyclable rubbish being placed in yellow recycling bins, according to council solid waste manager Angie Taylor.

"Almost a quarter of what the council collects from yellow wheelie bins is being dumped as rubbish," she says.

This rubbish not only includes items that shouldn't go into the yellow bin, like food waste, but also recyclable containers that still contain food. All bottles and containers need to be washed before going in the yellow bin, including milk bottles, jars, yoghurt containers and tin cans.

"We can only recycle clean containers. Not only are unwashed containers sent to landfill, but they can also contaminate clean recycling which then also has to be dumped as rubbish.

It's a waste to dump so much and this creates a cost to both the council and to ratepayers," she says. "It's in everyone's best interest to recycle as much as possible, but we need your help to make recycling work."

The Mackenzie District Council deals with about 16 tonnes of recycling each month, including both wheelie bin items and recycling dropped off at the Resource Recovery Parks.

But also, 4.2 tonnes of waste from yellow bins goes into landfill each month instead of being recycled. "This is what we want to reduce," Ms Taylor says. Roadside audits of wheelie bins are currently taking place. If your bin does not contain the right recyclables, it won't be collected.

"If you are not sure what can be recycled, check the sticker under the lid of your yellow wheelie bin. And remember, all glass must go in the blue glass crate."



Have you considered standing for Mayor, being a Councillor or Community Board member? Election time is approaching fast with nominations opening from 19th July to noon on 16th August.

Election day is Saturday 12th October, carried out via postal voting.

Full training and support is given for those who have never been an elected member before.

If you are listed on the Parliamentary Roll for Waitaki you will automatically get a vote if you are registered as living somewhere in the Mackenzie District. If you need to update your details or enrol to become a voter contact the Electoral Commission on 0800 36 76 56.

If you own property in the Mackenzie District but live outside of the District you are also entitled to vote as a Ratepayer Elector. You need to contact the Council in order to enrol to become a Ratepayer Elector.

Two dogs went missing from Ashwick Flat a couple of weeks ago. A Golden Lab and Black Lab. The owner would appreciate any information that would shed some light on where they are or what happened to them.

Continue to be vigilant and wary of those computer scammers or fraudsters that are always trying new ways to part you from your hard earned money. They may phone and try to trick you into giving them access to your computer under the guise of fixing the security settings. If you receive a letter from overseas saying that you may be in line for a big inheritance of millions of dollars from a recently departed long lost relative, just use it to start the fire.

Two boxes of soft drinks were found on the back of a Ute in town that don't belong where they were found. They appear to have been taken from a shop somewhere.

Don't forget the simple things that may save your life or a trip to the hospital. Click that seat belt in before you start driving, even on those short distances around town.

Winter has a long way to go yet, so be careful out on those roads and remember to drive to the conditions. You are a long time dead, so there's no point in speeding up the process.







## Lake Tekapo School needs You

Here at Lake Tekapo we have a great little primary school, with two classrooms, a fantastic principal, and supportive community.

The children get a great classroom education mixed with weekly ice-skating or skiing lessons in the winter and outdoor adventures in the summer. The community is committed to having two teachers for our learners, but with 22 children we are just short of the threshold (26) to qualify for ministry funding for the second.

This means we need to fundraise to make up the salary of the second teacher. That's right selling cakes to fund a teacher! So we need to put all our fundraising into this effort, rather than things like funding ipads for teaching and learning, and it also means it is harder to attract and keep a second teacher when we are funding it ourselves, as we can only currently offer annual contracts. With four more children enrolled we would be fully funded for 2 teachers and have a secure future.

This would make a big impact on our viability.

**How can you help?** If you have school age children but logistically it is too difficult for you to get to Lake Tekapo school, please get in touch and lets see if we can work out a solution. If you are planning on employing new staff; if you employ staff with children, it could make a big impact on our community.

*May our goals take us as high as the mountains, our learning as deep as the lake, and our knowledge shine through like the night sky*


