## Tekapo Community Hall Now Available for Public

The upgraded Tekapo Community Hall has proven popular since it re-opened to the public a few weeks ago, but there is still room to book your meeting or event.

The hall recently had a \$500,000 upgrade with new heating, a new kitchen and improvements including opening up the north end of the hall for better access with new decking.

The Tennis courts have also been upgraded.

Mackenzie District Council community facilities manager Garth Nixon encourages locals to book and use the new facility. The hall includes a small meeting room for small groups, and larger rooms that are currently being used to host exercise classes, weddings, and large functions.

The Tekapo Community Hall can now host up to 200 people in comfort, and will help bring more visitors to Tekapo for major events such as the International Starlight Conference in October, with 200 astronomers attending.

## Erewhon Cup Tournament 2013

Our very own Mackenzie Bull Tahr team will be competing again in this history steeped tournament. The team is made up of highly skilled local players and some quality imports from Canada and Switzerland.



Ice Hockey first began in New Zealand in the 1930's on our frozen, southern lakes and farmers ponds. The very first Erewhon Cup tournament was held in 1937 in Albury and has been held on various outdoor ice locations every year since, apart from the war years.

With the Erewhon Cup providing the first sound building block for players to compete in, New Zealand ice hockey has been able to develop into what it is today. The sport has steadily grown and continues to evolve as clubs build on numbers and skill levels. There are now strong national men's and women's leagues within the country, with each region putting forward their top players to compete in round robin games for their own prestigious trophies. Our men's national team the Ice Blacks and our national women's team, the Ice Ferns, also represent our country in overseas tournaments.

NZ National League players will also be representing in the Erewhon Cup from Queenstown and Dunedin. These include a good mix of international players who join our leagues. Canadians, Americans and Europeans will be playing alongside some of our top NZ players.

But, after 76 years, The Erewhon Cup continues to celebrate grass roots hockey in the South Island and is about building club level hockey in our region to reach that higher standard. Mackenzie Ice Hockey, who is hosting the tournament, is offering the Fair Play Award to those teams who show the true spirit of the Erewhon Cup.

## Council Phone Survey Starts Soon

**Mackenzie ratepayers might get a phone call asking them to rate their council.**

A phone survey of randomly selected ratepayers has been commissioned by the Mackenzie District Council and will be conducted in August by Cinta Research.

Council Chief Executive Wayne Barnett says surveyors will phone a mix of ratepayers including residents from different parts of the district and holiday home owners who live outside the district.

"People who deal with the council regularly provide good feedback but we also want to find out what we do well, and not so well, from ratepayers the council doesn't normally have a lot of contact with," he says. "I want to let people know the phone survey is legitimate and a good way to provide feedback to the council. Please don't hang up."

Mr Barnett says the results of the survey will be used to improve or change services and get a better understanding of what the community would like from the council.

Cinta Research conducted a similar survey last year and the information collected contributed towards the annual plan.

## Hints and Tips to "Get Thru"

The Wellington Earthquakes are a timely reminder that it's not just Christchurch that gets earthquakes. Many people have used these recent quakes as a reminder to check their kit and make sure everything is up to date. Here are small things you can do to ensure that you "Get Thru" and many Christchurch residents have been sharing their tips with the people of Wellington via facebook and other social media sites.

- Plan how to stay in touch with family and friends. Text people if possible, and remember it's often easier to reach people outside of the affected area.
- Arrange a place for the family to meet before something happens
- If the phones are going to be overloaded or you leave your home, a temporary voicemail message that says you're safe.
- Store bottles of water in your freezer, it keeps the freezer economical and the water is fresh no matter how old.
- Always keep some cash on you, especially five and ten dollar notes and some coins. Credit cards and eftpos don't work when there's no power.
- Store a torch in each bedside drawer and if possible use a head torch as it will keep your hands free.
- Store a pair of shoes under the bed, after an earthquake many people injure themselves by walking around in bare feet in the dark.
- Use "command strips" to hang pictures on the wall, they are then less likely to fall off and get damaged.
- Attach a tiny light to your keychain
- Buy a phone charger that connects to the car cigarette lighter, then charge your mobile phone if the power is out.
- Ensure your pets are microchipped, it will help to locate your pet if it runs off in a quake.
- Keep your car at least half full of petrol

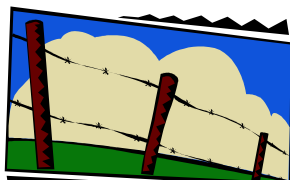

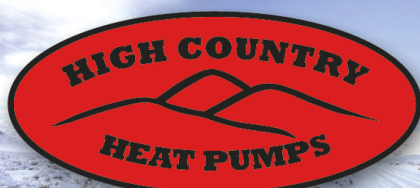

Also be sure to avoid piling up the glass crates so high, as when they are picked up it is easy for bottles to roll out. Which results with broken glass on the footpath or road.

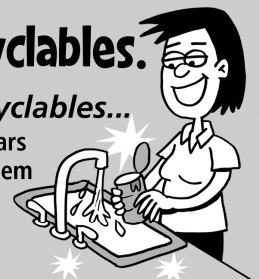

He recently competed in the World U23 regatta, Austria; gaining a silver medal in the U23 coxed 4.

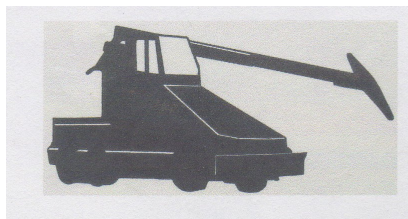
