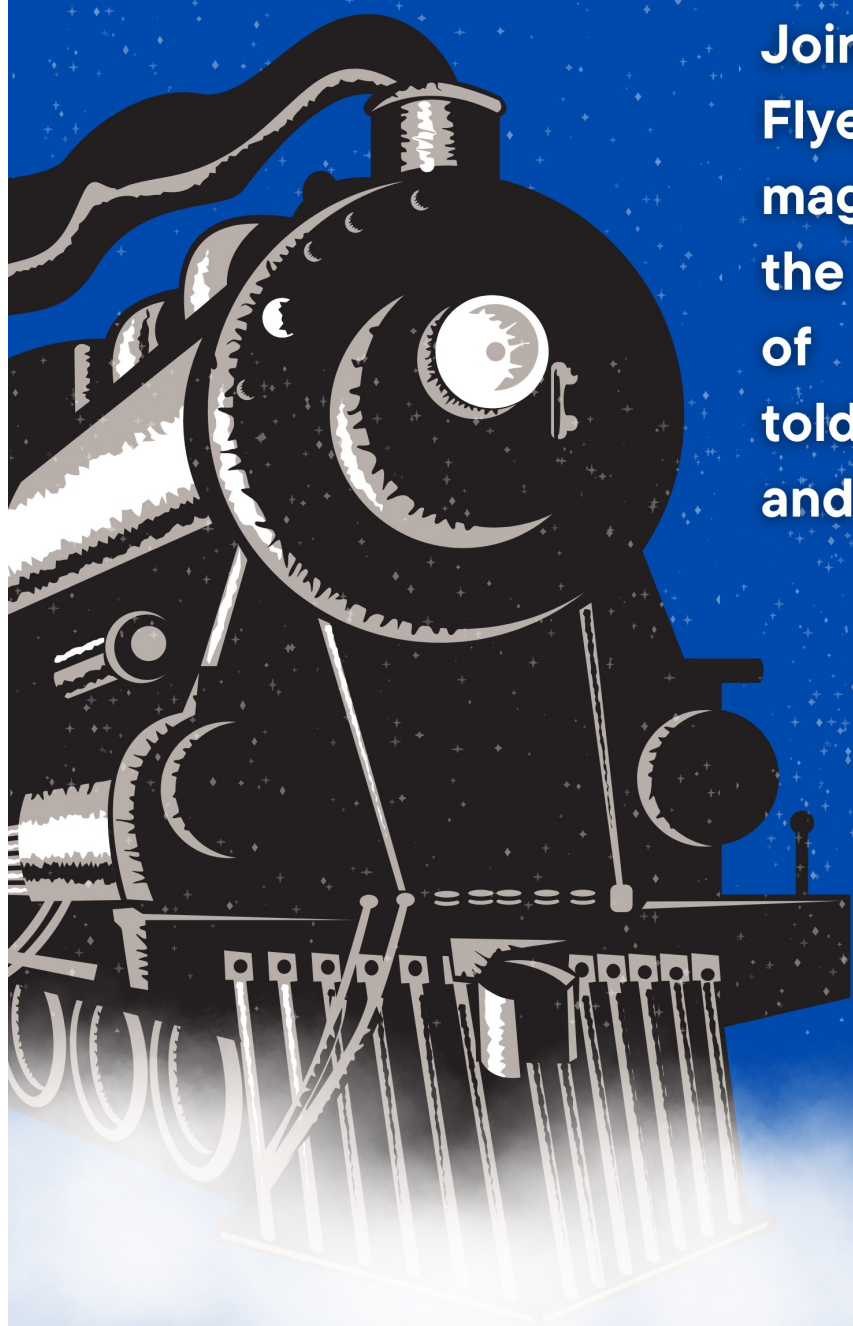

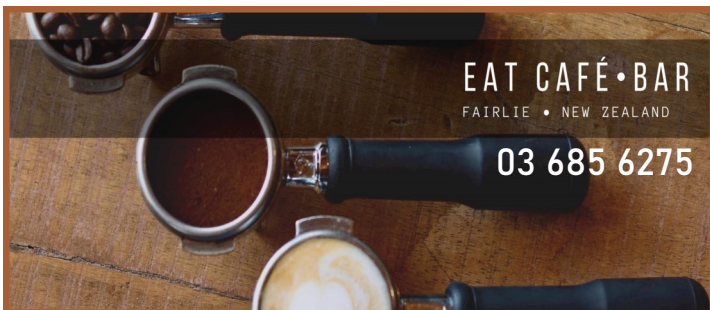

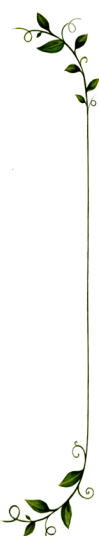

Mackenzie Bull Tahrs win Bronze at Nationals.

Last weekend 8 of our U12 players attended the National U12 Ice Hockey Tournament in Christchurch. This tournament is a club based tournament and had 5 teams from Auckland, 3 from Wellington, 5 from Christchurch, 3 from Dunedin, 2 from Queenstown and one from Alexandra, Gore and Mackenzie attending.

The players from the Mackenzie Club, based in Tekapo, had the daunting task of playing against teams who have the ability to skate all year round. Mackenzie only has ice for 3 months of the year and hadn't had the chance to be in their skates for 6 weeks prior to the tournament.

The Mackenzie Bull Tahrs played every team in a round robin tournament finishing fifth equal on the points table. For organisers to determine who was going to take the fifth spot they looked at the result of the head-to-head game between the two teams - it was a draw, they then looked at the points differential - both teams were on +31, so they then looked at the amount of goals scored by each team throughout the tournament - the Bull Tahrs had scored one goal more than the other team so they were awarded the fifth place spot.

Bull Tahrs then had to play off in the 4th v 5th place game. This was a must win game if we wanted to be in contention for a medal. It was a really intense, high pressure game and the Bull Tahr scored the winning goal with only 4 seconds left on the clock. They then had to play off for the bronze medal. This game was also high pressure with the score being 2-2 at full time. The game went into sudden death overtime and the Bull Tahrs scored the winning goal just under a minute in.

After 22 games of ice hockey, the Mackenzie Bull Tahrs had won 14, drew 5 and lost 3, bringing home the Bronze Medal in the U12 National Ice Hockey Tournament, a tournament that had previously been completely dominated by Auckland. Congratulations Mackenzie Bull Tahrs U12's.

Cannington School

During the last week of Term 3 we supported Mental Health Awareness Week by celebrating Healthy Food. Thinking back about our efforts in the school kitchen, Jack interviewed some of the students. Angus said his favorite thing was the smoothie because "I love banana, and mixing it with mango was delicious."

"My favorite meal was the tacos because it was just like nachos," said Ayla. Skyla's favorite was the freshly made hummus with carrot and celery sticks, that we had on the last day. Skyla offered to eat all the leftover hummus and took it home in a container! Annie loved the smoothies. She managed to clean up all the surplus smoothies every day. Heidi is always telling us "I'm not a sweet person" and she said she liked the smoothies because they weren't too sweet. Hadley enjoyed cutting up the mushrooms for the kebabs. Even though he said "I'm scared of eating mushrooms because some of them are poisonous." He did try them but decided they were not for him! Ashers favorite was the rice balls we had with a chicken salad. Jack and Skyla made us an awesome broccoli salad with spring onions and avocado mixed with pasta. All the students took part in preparing our morning teas and lunches during the week. All of them agreed they learnt new skills and that the tacos and rice balls were the best except for Hadley, Jakobe, and Angus whose favourite for the week was pita pockets.

Wednesday 20th September was the great Cannington Archeological Dig. We dug in our large sandpit that had been divided into 12 areas using blue scrapers as our digging tools. We found many artifacts including a whole human skeleton and bones from a rat, walnuts and mussel shells, coins from many different countries. There were bottle caps, a compass and an old watch, rocks with pictures drawn on them, old toys made of wood and plastic. There were fossil leaves, pieces of wood and shells that looked like ancient tools.

Our hypothesis is 'that the prehistoric people at Cannington School used money and traveled the world. They used tools and played with wooden toys. They ate nuts, seeds and mussels; we think they liked KFC because we found a distinctive red plastic spoon. Our artifacts were a mix of old things and modern things.

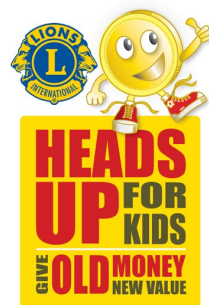

THE BOOKSELLER AT THE END OF THE WORLD and BOOKSHOP DOGS

by Ruth Shaw

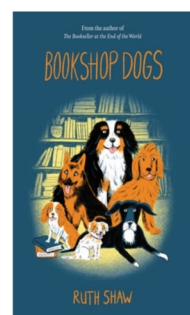
Ruth Shaw is the bestselling author of *The Bookseller at the End of the World*. In 2016, in her late sixties, Ruth opened her first little bookshop in Manapōuri, Fiordland where she had settled with her husband Lance. They were quickly followed by a wee shop for children's books and another that is filled with books that men might like. *The Bookseller at the End of the World*, consists partly of short vignettes about the people who visit her book-shops. This includes the story of how Ruth refused to sell a stack of books with green covers to a customer who had selected them to suit her home décor rather than to read them. The book is also an honest account of her earlier life. The bookshop stories are interwoven with her own ocean adventures and her tragedies – the rape as a teenager, the adoption of her first-born son, the death of another son shortly after birth and depression. These stories are told in short, clear chapters and without a hint of self-pity.

Bookshop Dogs is Ruth Shaw's second book (publication date 24 October). In this book Ruth shares autobiographical stories that focus on Hunza the German shepherd who worked alongside her when she was a youth worker in Invercargill. Hunza played an essential role in Ruth's ability to gain trust from troubled teens and gang members. They are interesting and beautiful stories about the impact Hunza had on the lives of these young people. What a way to begin our 2023/2024 season by travelling through to Ashburton. 20 members were treated to an amazing day by visiting 2 large gardens.

'Akaunui' on Longbeach Road was mind blowing -30 acres of garden and lawns which take 16 hours to mow and Diana does all this herself! The expansive gardens surround a beautiful brick homestead built in 1905. The setting of the house is stunning with mature plantings, manicured lawns, creative box hedging, rose gardens, huge vegetable gardens, espaliered apple tree alley, and numerous ponds. Diana has created vistas within her garden and a large pond curved around her vast collection of trees and shrubs which presented the most spectacular view of the homestead.



Collections of rhododendrons and associated plants, formal and less formal gardens, many roses, and hydrangeas, winter roses, delphiniums form part of a very striking formal circular garden.

The newest part of her garden is 10 acres of nature-rich designed wetland with a marshy swale bordered by native flaxes and grasses. She has also created a 6-hole golf course within this area. Diana's passion and knowledge of the plants and trees in her garden and her willingness to share her garden with garden lovers is a 'must' for everyone. Her enthusiasm and energy for her huge garden is amazing.

Lunch and purchases at Lushingtons and then onto 'Glendare' in Hinds – a subtropical oasis. Gay and her late husband began work on their home in 1995 and 24 years later their hard work designing, constructing and planting was completed. The results are an incredible testimony to their hard work and perseverance. We walked from the carpark, up a few rustic steps with palm trees on either side and what a surprise! It suddenly opened up to an expansive 15 acre irrigation lake where the family enjoy swimming, water skiing, biscuiting and fishing. A grassed area looking out on the lake surrounded by native plantings and looking towards the Southern Alps in the distance was picture perfect. Down more steps into the secluded garden area surrounding the house.

It's always a great morning to catch up with what people are planting and to not only swap or give-away plants but also ideas and tips. This year we will put on a morning tea so if anyone wants to bring a plate of goodies to share, that would be wonderful!



A waterfall cascading over enormous boulders is an amazing site as are the beautiful plantings around the cleverly designed garden. The numerous palm trees and punga provided a tropical garden oasis. Enormous fences erected from reclaimed power poles and shelter cloth provide vital protection from our famous nor'westerlies. Gay spoke of their love for 'old stuff' and as a result they have found treasures such as anchor chain from a Russian ship along the steps and a boiler from the old Kaiapoi freezing works repurposed as a garden ornament.

Gay is so proud of their home – but that's another story. We were lucky to view some of their treasures which showcase the hours of work Gay and her husband have put into their home -schist rock, natural products and history, Fijian kauri doors, macrocarpa kitchen bench sourced from a tree in Geraldine, an old bridge beam from the Rakaia Gorge forms the mantelpiece, interior walls are plastered in a textural organic swiss influenced finish. The remains of a Russian satellite sits above the fireplace which dates back to 1972 when the ball fell from the sky into a stubble paddock on their farm. A truly magical spot and one we will never forget.

Aorangi Vets Services Looks Back and Celebrates!

This spring, Aorangi Vet Services (AVS) is proudly celebrating 45 years of service to Canterbury and the Mackenzie country with 45 days of competitions, prizes, deals, giveaways and in-clinic talks.

Fairlie Clinic Manager, Heather Hellmrich, is enthusiastic about the celebration "each week we're featuring a different theme, alternating between companion and rural animals, so there's something for everyone."

There is also a grand prize up for grabs, an exclusive weekend for up to 14 people at the fabulous Blue Mountain Station lodge and lake house, valued at around \$2,500. Anyone who purchases product or services during the birthday period will automatically go in the draw to win.

In coming weeks there will be free dental checks in clinic, plus a DeWalt Drill set up for grabs, so Heather encourages everyone to keep an eye out for the changing themes and competitions.

The origins of Aorangi Vet Services date back to the mid 1950's, when Dave (later Mayor of the Timaru District) and Priscilla Walker set up their vet practice in the front room of their home on North Street in Timaru. Dave was a former Air Force pilot and served much of the region by air.

In the early 70's, clinics were opened in Fairlie and Geraldine, predominately servicing sheep and beef farming clients, as well as providing veterinary services for pet animals.

Aorangi Vet Services was formally incorporated in 1978 by Dave and Priscilla, with Kevin O'Grady becoming one of the partners and taking over the operation of the Fairlie Branch from Stuart Moffat.

In 2007 the Fairlie clinic moved from its tiny building on Allandale Road into the old Wrightson's building on the Main Street in Fairlie. Providing them with a far bigger retail area and a much better workspace, this is this location that the team is proud to call home today.

That year also heralded the arrivals of the first of the current partner group, Aaron McCullough, a local Geraldine lad, and Glenda Kellahan, who is now the lead vet at the Fairlie clinic.

Sally Duncan then joined the Geraldine clinic as a fresh-faced new graduate in 2010, becoming a partner in 2018 along with another familiar South Cantabrian, Peter Crawford.

In 2020, Glenda became a partner and was also joined at the board table by Canadian Nathan Roberts, and Neroli Wall, who had both been working out of Ashburton for a number of years.

From humble beginnings, AVS now employs more than fifty staff across three clinics. Many are long serving, with a handful racking up more than 180 years combined service, including Heather who has been a friendly face at the Fairlie clinic for more than a decade. Being a Fairlie native, Heather remembers visits to see Dr Kevin with the family's Springer Spaniel when she was a child.

Heather and Glenda are joined by Karen, Becki and Emma who work together to support the clients and the vets. They all share a love of animals and a passion for the Fairlie community.

The breadth and depth of knowledge and experience across the team means that clients feel welcomed, known and understood, with AVS priding itself on providing access to the latest approaches in veterinary medicine.

As AVS celebrates its first 45 years and looks forward to a bright future, Glenda, reflects on the amazing experience that living and working in Fairlie has given her "Aorangi Vets Fairlie gave me an opportunity to become part of an amazing community and along the way that has added greatly to my life and that of my family. The variety of veterinary work I am privileged to experience here keeps every day interesting and brings with it the challenges that feed the fire. I'm so proud to be 'out there doing it!'"

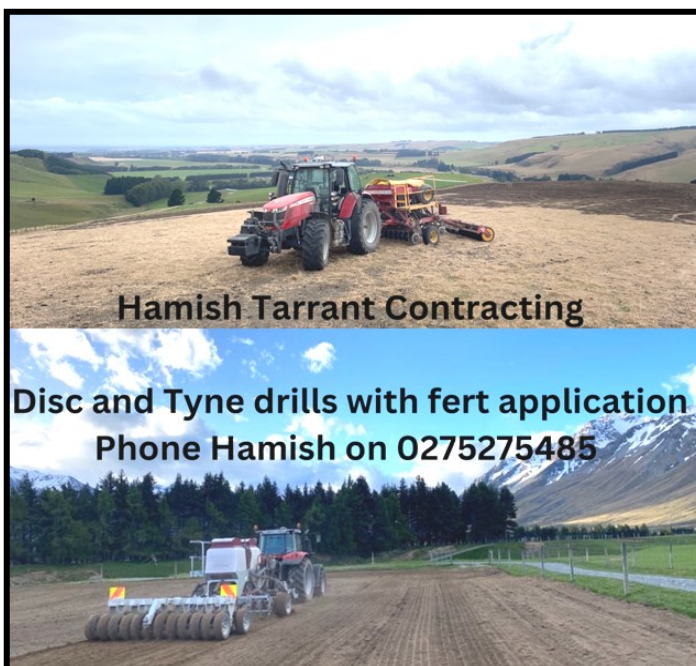

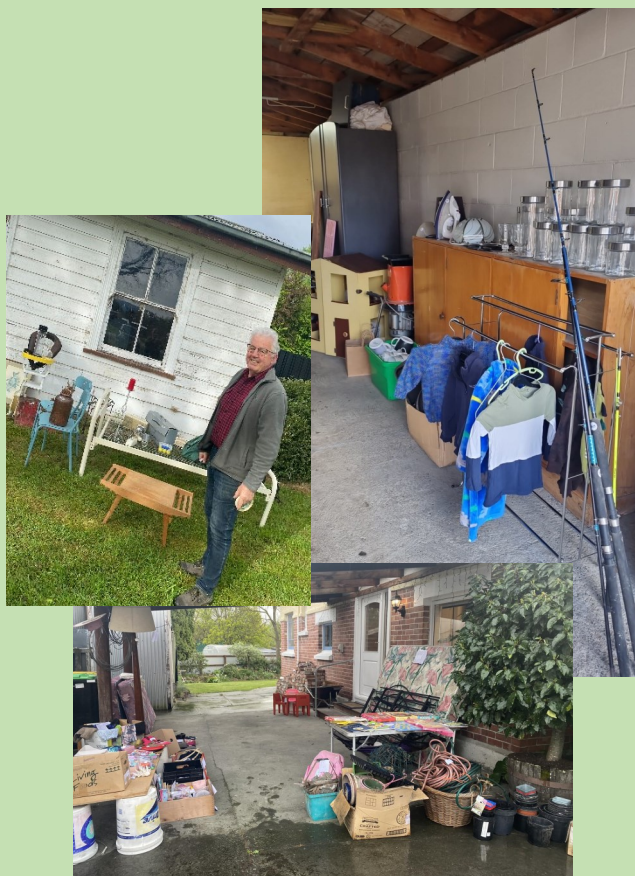
